

# CAMPER PACKING LIST

*This is a guide for packing. It is not necessary to go out and buy every item on the list—use your own judgment and make substitutions. Please remember your camper will be very active and camp is rough on clothes. For this reason, we recommend that campers do not bring expensive clothing to camp. All clothes are subject to water, sand, mud, spills, grass stains, paint, and/or tie-dye.*

*Please DO NOT bring any of the following: gum, portable stereos, hand-held video games, pocketknives, mobile phones, pagers, or laptop computers. Campers found with these items will have them confiscated by his/her counselor and returned at the end of the session. Food brought to camp will be stored outside the cabin and shared with the entire cabin group. Possession of tobacco products, alcohol, and/or illegal drugs is grounds for immediate dismissal from camp.*

*We try our best returning any lost items we find. However, your camper is responsible to ensure that nothing is lost. To help, please counsel your child to keep close track of all items. Also, please label everything your child brings to camp. The chance of items making their way back home is much greater if they are labeled.*

**SLEEPING:** PAJAMAS  
SLEEPING BAG & PILLOW, no quilt/sheet combos permitted, due to overnight campouts  
BACKPACK for out-of-camp trip, ALL VOYAGER CAMPERS

**CLOTHES:** SHIRTS, t-shirts and at least 2 long-sleeve shirts for evenings  
SHORTS, 1 pair for each day of your stay  
PANTS/JEANS, 2 pairs are recommended for evenings  
SWIM SUIT, camp appropriate please  
SOCKS, 1 pair for each day of your stay, plus 1 extra  
UNDERWEAR, 1 pair for each day of your stay, plus 1 extra  
SHOES, old gym shoes, hard soles with support  
JACKET/SWEATSHIRT  
RAINCOAT/PONCHO  
HAT  
LAUNDRY BAG or plastic trash bag for wet/muddy/dirty clothes

**MUD HIKE:** OLD CLOTHES YOU MAY NEVER SEE AGAIN or ever get clean  
OLD LACE-UP SHOES/BOOTS, sorry no sandals on mud hike

**TOILETRIES:** SOAP & SHAMPOO  
TOOTHBRUSH & TOOTHPASTE  
DEODORANT  
COMB/BRUSH  
BATH TOWEL & WASHCLOTH  
BEACH TOWEL  
BUCKET to carry toiletries

**OTHER:** PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS, do not pack in luggage and keep in original container  
WAMPUM BEADS from past years at camp  
INSECT REPELLENT, non-aerosol please  
FLASHLIGHT

**OPTIONAL:** WATER BOTTLE, available at the camp store  
T-SHIRT TO TYE-DYE  
DISPOSABLE CAMERA, please write your camper's name on it  
BALL GLOVE  
FISHING POLE & TACKLE  
WATERPROOF BOOTS  
SANDALS  
PEN, PENCIL & SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPES

**HORSEBACK RIDING:**  
CLOSED-TOED SHOES WITH HEEL, boots work best  
LONG PANTS TO RIDE IN, jeans work best

As a way to continue to instill the values of Respect, Caring, Faith, Responsibility, and Honesty we will be showing it at camp in a unique way this summer.
