

# ENLIGHTENING FUTURES

On November 16, 2021, the YMCA of Greater Fort Wayne hosted a press conference to introduce the YMCA Enterprise Zone to community members. This education curriculum will introduce youth and young adults to career fields that require technical expertise and hands-on work, including construction trades, computer science and culinary arts. Through partnerships and current YMCA programs, participants will also explore careers in manufacturing, health sciences, human services and media/communication.

The 20,000-square-foot building will be situated immediately north of the Renaissance Pointe YMCA on property generously donated by the McMillen Foundation. The location is ideal because it minimizes travel and provides a catalyst for neighborhood economic development. This three-phase project will include a Career Opportunities Center, an Outdoor Corner Park and Athletic and Special Event fields.

# INFUSING COMMUNITY HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

“ I started coming to the YMCA after welcoming a 17-month-old child into our home, making us a family of six. I knew I needed to start focusing on my health, but to do that, I needed access to affordable, quality child care. Thankfully, the Y allowed me to prioritize my health while my youngest enjoyed Y child care programs.

For the first two years, I only used the fitness area. As I grew more comfortable with the many resources provided at the Y, I found myself following music I heard in the hallway, leading me to a Zumba class.

Thirteen months later, I'm proud to say that I still go to the same class, and I love it! When I started, I was awful. I still don't follow all the moves or stay on beat the whole time, but my confidence has grown, and I'm stronger for it. The instructor, Zarifa, is an encourager — never making anyone feel dumb but pushing us to give more — which is huge in a class like this.

The people in that class have become another little community for me, and I look forward to seeing them twice a week. And our youngest child always looks forward to child care — he just loves it. Whenever we walk in, staff members welcome him by name, and whenever we leave, he tells me which friends were there. I don't worry about whether he will be OK — I know he's safe. ”

# SPARKING GENEROSITY

The first step is sometimes the hardest. That's how the Maxwell family felt when they decided to apply for financial assistance. They knew a YMCA membership would benefit their family, but the full price was out of their budget. They felt the familiar struggle of not wanting to ask for help.

The day they received financial assistance from the YMCA, Tara made a promise that she would share that spirit of generosity with others and someday pay it forward. At the time, Tara was a full-time nursing student, commuting between Valparaiso and Fort Wayne during the week and working nights at Parkview on the weekends.



Once the Maxwells joined the Y, Tara and her husband, Jason, got involved in group exercise and aquatic fitness classes, while their kids began using the fitness equipment and playing basketball in the gym. "We love that the Y has something for our whole family at one location, and we all enjoy being there. We also feel safe letting our teenage son exercise on his own."

Recently, Tara graduated from nursing school and is now a Nurse-Family Partnership nurse helping first-time moms. The Maxwell family no longer needs financial assistance, and in November of 2021, Tara fulfilled the original promise she made — she called the Central Branch and arranged to pay for another family who needed assistance for the next two years. Tara was so overwhelmed with joy when being told about the family she would help, and the family who received the membership felt blown away that a stranger could provide such a generous gift.
