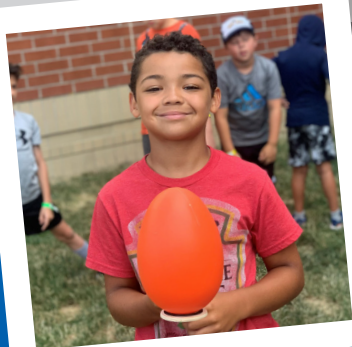

MOVE Teen Summer Series, is an engaging summer program providing weeklong service and hands on learning projects.

MOVE runs Monday-Friday, 9:00am – 4:00pm. Check in will begin at 8:45am at

the Parkview Family YMCA. There will be no before or after care provided. Teen campers are allowed to be in the YMCA by themselves until the start of the program or picked up.

Youth will be traveling by foot or via the mini-bus to serve and do hands on learning project sites in the Fort Wayne area. Examples of agencies they will visit: Community Harvest Food Bank, Parks and Recreation, Rescue Mission, Neighbor Link and more.

Under the supervision of certified and trained YMCA adult team leaders, youth will take time to learn about and volunteer for each individual agency they will serve. Staff and youth will discuss the goals of each project and end each day with a reflection process. In addition, the group will engage in meaningful conversations and activities around building a healthy spirit, mind and body as well as how to be caring, honest, respectful and responsible.

- Required Forms are online on the Parkview Y branch page
- YMCA Immunization Record Form must be completed and signed by a health care provider
- \$15 non-refundable deposit per week registered for each child
- Balance is due the Monday prior to the week your child will be attending
- Payment must be made in the form of scheduled automatic deductions via a bank draft or credit card
- We offer financial assistance for members and program participants. Aid is based on need and is kept strictly confidential
- All requests for cancellation must be made in writing to the appropriate director no later than two weeks prior to the week cancelling payment due date
- Only 1/2 of the camp fee will be refundable if this registration is canceled less than two weeks prior to payment due date
- No refunds are given if cancellation is less than one week from attendance
