

Former pastor of Anchor Community Church, Tim Hallman, joined the YMCA of Greater Fort Wayne as the Christian Emphasis Director almost three years ago. YMCA branch directors have even started to invite NeighborLink staff into their programming that includes active older adults and staff training on effective storytelling.

Over the past few years Marty and Tim have been working hard to remind its members that the Y is far more than just a fitness center and it's beginning to show fruit as relationships develop and the questions about service grow deeper in nature. Tim's done a great job to focus the call to volunteering and service not just on the transactional level, but as a way for members to tangibly strengthen the foundations of our community through Christian principles. The Y is also about youth development, healthy living,

and social responsibility and they see NeighborLink as a vital partner in their work to transform lives.

This is one of the most authentic and significant partnerships that NeighborLink has had in its 15 years, aligning mission and activity together towards mutual goals of loving, caring and serving; both with hearts to see relationships developed, neighbors connected, and holistic personal development
